Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Indicator List for the Hotel Staff

What are some of the signs I should be looking out for when interacting with colleagues / staff / team members?

The list below contains types of indicators that would raise your suspicion. If you notice 3 or more of these indicators, please follow the process for reporting indicators.

Physical appearance: may show signs of abuse, appear malnourished, exhausted or unkempt
☐ Isolation: may associate rarely with co-workers at work or outside of working hours
☐ Few or no personal possessions: may have few personal possessions and might always wear the same clothes day in day out
☐ Restricted freedom of movement: may not be able to move freely outside of work
☐ Unusual travel times: show signs that their movements are controlled, victims may be dropped off/collected for work on a regular basis either very early or late at night
■ Multiple people listing the same address, phone number, bank account and/or next of kin on work records
☐ Holiday request is submitted through the HR system by any other employee other than the one requesting the holiday
■ Work excessively long hours over long periods, have to resort to crime in order to get food or money for food, may need to scavenge for food
